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SUMMARY

- Built AI/product systems from zero in ambiguous environments, without a predefined playbook.
 - Example: Founded AI Grants India from scratch as a public-good AI developer ecosystem program, building the grant/application flows, AI gateways, SDKs, Codex CLI proxies, onboarding, API docs, examples, quests, showcases, and partner-credit operations around a new category of Indian AI builders.
 - Example: Built a TCP-based coding assistant that can run on a fresh Mac or Linux machine without prior installs, plus terminal recording and multi-user terminal collaboration tools.
- Shipped early prototypes, measured real user behavior, and iterated quickly based on feedback.
 - Example: Spends regular hands-on time vibing coding AIGI marketing, signup, and onboarding flows to make it easier for developers to get started.
 - Example: Tracks AIGI usage through token volume, API key activity, referrals, pitch/application funnels, GitHub activity, event participation, partner-credit distribution, and startup outcomes; AIGI-issued API keys reached roughly 3B tokens/month during Feb-Mar.
- Created developer-facing tools, APIs, SDKs, docs, demos, or internal platforms that increased adoption.
 - Example: Built AIGI developer infrastructure including AI gateways, SDKs, Codex CLI proxies, onboarding/signup flows, API documentation, examples, live quests, project showcases, leaderboards, and content systems.
 - Example: Created an OpenAI-like dashboard SDK to bootstrap API key management, org settings, login, forums, and related SaaS admin features in a few lines.
 - Example: Authored `ekaf`, an Erlang Kafka client with 150+ stars.
- Used AI agents/coding tools deeply in daily work, with concrete productivity or product outcomes.
 - Example: Built Codex CLI proxies, Code.film as a Codex demo studio, terminal session recording, and multi-user terminal collaboration workflows.
 - Example: Built chatbot systems using intent classifiers, LLMs, state machines, and WebSocket-based agent-like workflows; the chatbot answers roughly 90% of incoming queries.
 - Example: Built and operated automated AI phone-call workflows, including 100,000 automated AI phone calls.
- Demonstrated fast ramp-up into new domains and delivered production-quality results.
 - Example: Moved across AI developer ecosystems, fintech, embedded finance, internal tools, cards, customer support, mobile infrastructure, adtech, and distributed systems while repeatedly building production systems.
 - Example: Built a customer journey creator with React, Postgres, ClickHouse, S3, and Node.js that scaled to 3B events within 6 months and sends millions of notifications across SMS, push, email, and WhatsApp.
- Balanced technical depth with product judgment, user empathy, and clear communication.
 - Example: Combines builder credibility with founder empathy through AI Grants India, helping students, indie hackers, technical founders, researchers, and startups move from first API call to shipped product.
 - Example: At Bon Credit, translated financial infrastructure into products used by 50,000+ gig-economy workers, lenders, operations teams, and auditors.
- Worked cross-functionally with engineering, product, design, research, sales, or customer teams.
 - Example: Leads a 15-person internal products team at OneCard across engineering, engineering management, and product management, with dotted-line collaboration across DevOps and data science.
